The site is 58 acres, with lots of interesting history, incredible views, and a huge beach. In order to ensure the property functions safely and is protected for future visitors, we are working with the community to create adequate parking facilities, provide comfort stations and trail access to the beach, build a ranger station, and design an iconic overlook area.

FINDING THE BALANCE

This will be a recreational and cultural resource for everyone. The project team will share three alternatives that consider changes to the site at a minimal, moderate, and intense level.

The goal is to find the right balance between providing safe access and creating recreational opportunities, while restoring sensitive habitat and protecting the bluffs and beach from detrimental impacts.
