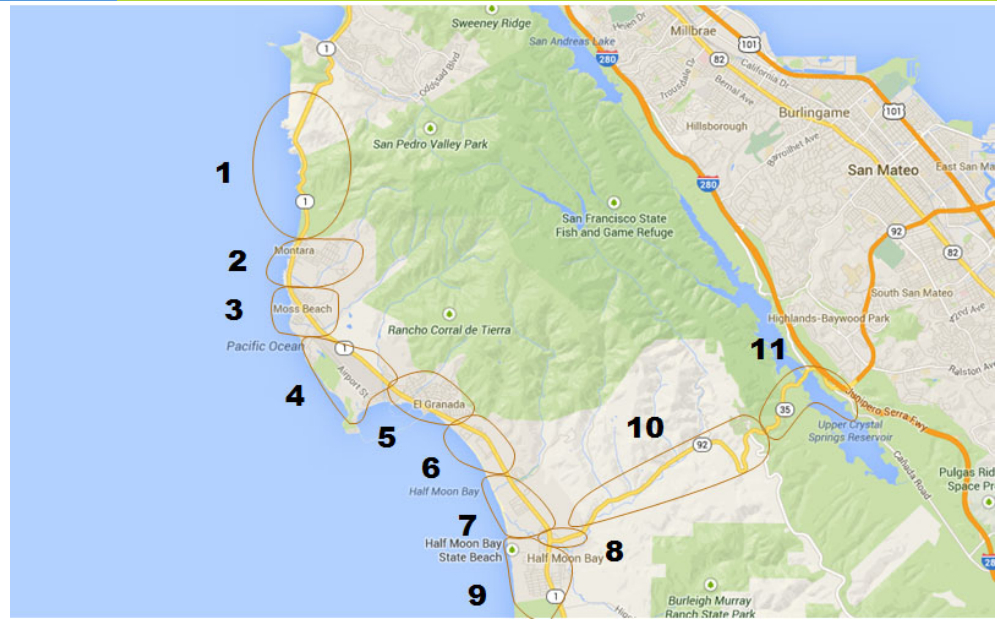

# What is Connect the Coastsides?

➔ **Connect the Coastsides** is a Comprehensive Transportation Management Plan that will identify programs and improvements along Highway 1, Highway 92 and our arterial roads to accommodate the Midcoast's future transportation needs.





# What is Connect the Coastsides?

- ➔ The Plan will evaluate the existing and future residential and non-residential development potential of the Midcoast and City of Half Moon Bay by conducting a land use build-out analysis and an assessment of the current and future transportation system.





# What is Connect the Coastsides?

- ➔ The Plan will also provide an assessment of implementation costs and identify potential sources of funding.
- ➔ The project is a requirement of the California Coastal Commission's approval of the County's Local Coastal Program.



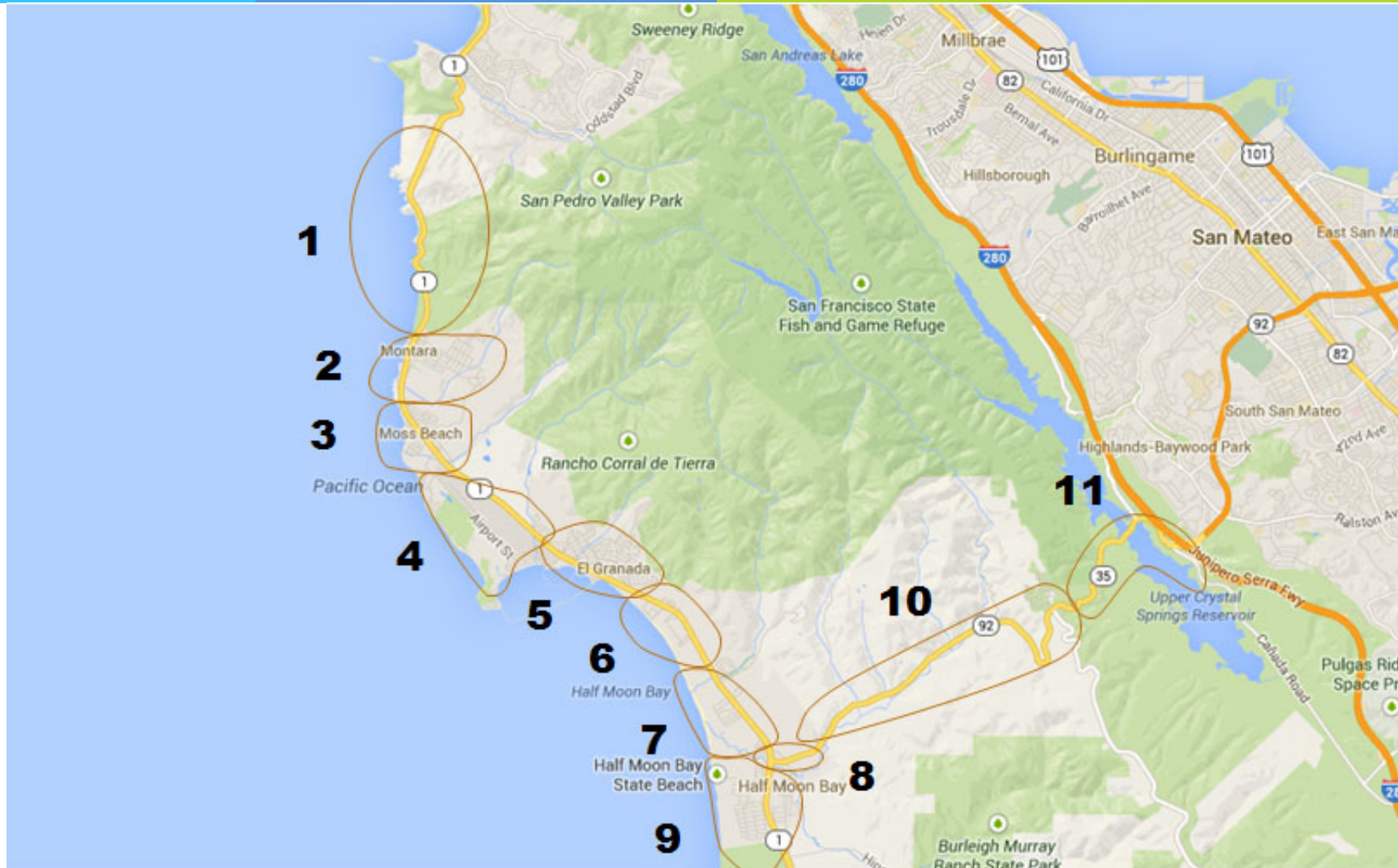


# What is Connect the Coastsides?
